The "A" Elements

Letterforms: Aa

Sign Language: A, APPLE

Colors: Aqua, Apricot, Amber, Amethyst, Aquamarine, Azure, Auburn

<u>Trait Tracker:</u> Appreciation

<u>Planter:</u> Astilbe / Aloe Vera / Ajuga <u>Ground Plants:</u> Aloe, Apple Trees

<u>Equine:</u> Appaloosa, Arabian, Ardennes <u>Visual:</u> Apricot Suncatchers, Acorns

Every Sensory Station also features a human first aid kit, equine first aid kit, hitching post, planter and storage barn. Every two stations share a mounting block.

The "A" Experience

Service Projects:
